ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO.16, s. 2016
2016 BRIGADA ESKWELA IMPLEMENTATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief, SGOD and CID and Staff
Elementary/ Secondary School Heads
Section Chiefs, Non- Teaching Personnel and All Concerned

1. In compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 35, s. 2016, re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela 2016 also known as National Schools Maintenance Week slated on **May 30 to June 4, 2016** with the theme: "**Tayo para sa Paaralang Ligtas, Maayos at Handa, Mula Kindergarten Hanggang Senior High School**". All public elementary and secondary school heads are required to organize local school maintenance effort that engages all educational stakeholders to contribute their time, effort and resources to ensure that school facilities are prepared before the opening of classes.
2. The School Division Office together with all public elementary and secondary schools will hold a caravan on May 30, 2016. A kick off ceremony will be held simultaneously at 7:00AM in three teams: **1- Centro and Mayon Unit, 2- Upland Unit (Assembly area: Paulba National High School) and 3- Coastal Unit (Assembly area: Catburawan ES).**
3. Team 1 will have the following assembly areas: **LWCES (B) for schools located at the Centro and LCNTVHS for Mayon Unit.** The route of the caravan will traverse from Mahaba passing along Busay, Barayong and Herrera and will converge at LCNTVHS. Schools such as Binanowan, Tobgon, Batang, Layon, BRSHS and Paulog will meet the caravan at LECS and will head towards Diversion Road going to Bonga, Pandan, Tastas and Ranao-Ranao. Meanwhile, Cavasi, Tinampo, Tula-Tula (Pequeno and Grande) will join the caravan as it passes their area moving to Paulba National High School where it will wind up.
4. Opening program shall commence at 9:00AM.
5. All assigned team leaders shall be responsible in organizing the participants and in leading the caravan in their expected route.
6. Expenses relative to the conduct of Brigada Eskwela activity shall be charged to local funds subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.
7. All other provisions of DepEd Memorandum # 16, s.2016 remain enforced.
